## New course: Is Aspirin the New Pregnancy Miracle Drug?

More than 33% of serious maternal deaths and 15% of preterm births are related to pre-eclampsia. Low-dose aspirin prophylaxis can reduce the incidence of pre-eclampsia by 17% to 25% for women at high or moderate risk for pre-eclampsia. In July 2018, the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologists and Society for Maternal and Fetal Medicine issued Joint Committee Opinion #743 with new recommendations for the use of low-dose aspirin prophylaxis to prevent and treat pre-eclampsia.

This course will improve perinatal providers' understanding and application of the new guidelines into clinical practice.
